

Policy Regarding Lapsed Memberships

Saddlebrooke Dog Park members may not renew their annual membership for any number of reasons, such as the death of a dog or relocating to another location. When a member allows his/her membership to lapse by failing to pay the annual fee by January 31, their key card will be deactivated on or about February 15th as per the current policy regarding renewals. The key card is owned by the member and they shall retain the key card for possible future use.

Should a lapsed member wish to rejoin the association at some point in the future, they can renew their membership by paying the current yearly renewal fee plus a reactivation fee of \$10.00. If a key card has been lost or damaged there will be a \$10.00 charge for a new one.

To reactivate an inactive membership, the returning member should fill out a New Membership form, noting that he/she is a returning member. Please note on the form the last year that the membership was active.
